

HEIDELBERG TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NO. 3
ADOPTED November 6, 1964

HEIDELBERG TOWNSHIP, LEBANON COUNTY, DOG ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING OWNERS, CUSTODIANS AND KEEPERS OF DOGS FROM ALLOWING SUCH DOGS TO RUN AT LARGE IN THE TOWNSHIP OF HEIDELBERG, LEBANON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA: AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Supervisors of Heidelberg Township, Lebanon County, as follows:

SECTION 1: It shall be unlawful for the owner, custodian or keeper of any dog to allow such dog to run at large at any time, either upon any of the streets, alleys, or public grounds of Heidelberg Township, Lebanon County, or upon the property of any one other than the owner, custodian or keeper of such dog unless accompanied by and under the control of such owner, custodian or keeper.

SECTION 2: It shall be the duty of the owner, custodian, keeper or attendant of any dog while traveling upon the streets, alleys or public grounds in the Township of Heidelberg to have all dogs under sufficient control so as to prevent dogs from entering the property of any persons in the Township of Heidelberg without the owners consent.

SECTION 3: Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof before any Justice-of-the-Peace of the Township of Heidelberg, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than Five (\$5.00) Dollars, nor more than Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars and costs of prosecution, and in default of the payment of the fine and costs, shall undergo imprisonment in the Lebanon County Prison for a period of not more than ten (10) days.
