**A RESOLUTION AMENDING AND ESTABLISHING CERTAIN FEES FOR
HEIDELBERG TOWNSHIP WATER AND SEWER SYSTEM SERVICES**

WHEREAS, Heidelberg Township owns and operates public water and sanitary sewer systems; and

WHEREAS, Heidelberg Township has set certain fees related to water and sewer system services; and

WHEREAS, Heidelberg Township has reviewed its current fees to determine whether they adequately reflect the cost of providing services and equipment to water and sewer customers; and

WHEREAS, the Supervisors of Heidelberg Township wish to update and establish fees for certain water and sewer system services and equipment.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
OF HEIDELBERG TOWNSHIP AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The following fees shall be effective upon adoption of this Resolution:

Meter set up and installation fee
for new residential meters serving water
or sewer customers (public water or wells)

\$450.00

Meter set up and installation fee
for non-residential meters

Actual cost of equipment
plus water operator's
standard rate for service


Replacement of any meter component
or MXU damaged by misuse,
neglect, or interference

Actual cost of component
plus water operator's
standard rate for service

2. No other fees for water or sewer services established by Heidelberg Township shall be repealed or modified by this Resolution. All Resolutions, Ordinances, or parts thereof not inconsistent with this Resolution shall remain in full force and effect.




